



Players Participating in the Long Island Championship & NY State High School Tournament Games

Dear LI Lacrosse Showcase Participants,

This year the Long Island Championship Games are on June 5th and the New York State High School Tournament Games will be played on June 11th and June 14th. These dates fall in the middle of the First Round of the Long Island Lacrosse Showcase. This presents a conflict for a small percentage of players that are members of a high school team that has advanced to that level of the lacrosse playoffs. The directors of the Long Island Lacrosse Showcase have created a policy to advance any such player to the Final 50 Round if their team is still **actively participating (either in practice or a game)** in the state tournament **on the day of the player's First Round Tryout**.

Below is the policy that will be implemented for those players:

- To be eligible for the Final 50 Round, all players must have registered for the Long Island Lacrosse Showcase **BEFORE** the First Round Tryout for their respective grade-level has their tryout.
- The player must be on the active roster for the varsity squad. Players brought up from the JV for the playoffs are considered on the active roster for the varsity squad. Verification of player status will be made with the varsity coach of the team.
